#### **Course Overview**

The objective of this course ACCA (TX) Local version is to familiarise students with the core tax concepts such as income tax, corporate tax, personal tax, social security contributions, VAT and others, and to teach them how these are being applied under the Maltese laws.

#### What do you need to start this course

#### Assesment

ACCA Taxation (TX) is the so-called 'session CBE', meaning that you can sit for it only during sessions published by ACCA. Exams are held 1st Week of June or 1st Week of December. Our tutors will guide you through the exam application procedure and share some useful tips throughout the course. To make you acquainted with the exam structure, we will hold a mock exam and 4 revision sessions at the end of the course.

#### **Progression routes**

On completing and passing exams of ACCA (TX) one can further study to obtain the Advanced Diploma in Accounting and Business by covering 5 more units from (LW-FM).
